PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Launched in 2010, the JT4 Jump Start Program was born of a collaborative partnership between JT4, LLC and the College of Southern Nevada (CSN). It provides individuals without prior technical experience with a path forward to a

rewarding career as an electronic technician.

Jump Start Program participants enroll in CSN's Associate of Applied Science Degree in Engineering Technology with Electronics – Defense Contractor Technician (ETDCT-AAS) program. After completing six specific courses in the

AAS) program. After completing six specific courses in the ETDCT-AAS degree curriculum with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher, students are eligible to apply for the position of Electronic Technician I with JT4, LLC. If hired, Jump Start Program participants may be permitted to attend up to 15 hours of classes per week while awaiting their clearances (subject to manager approval). Upon becoming employees, participants may also take advantage of JT4's tuition reimbursement program for their remaining classes. Because all courses are held on campus, the Jump Start Program is only available to participants in Southern Nevada.

GET YOUR JUMP START

To participate in the JT4 Jump Start Program, follow these six steps.

1. CONFIRM YOUR ELIGIBILITY FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH JT4.

Qualified applicants must:

QUALIFY FOR AND MAINTAIN A DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SECURITY OF FARANCE

PASS A DRUG SCREEN

POSSESS A VALID NEVADA DRIVER'S LICENSE

BE WILLING TO WORK IN REMOTE LOCATIONS

2. EXPRESS INTEREST IN THE JUMP START PROGRAM.

3. APPLY FOR THE ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE IN ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY WITH ELECTRONICS – DEFENSE CONTRACTOR TECHNICIAN PROGRAM.

4. ENROLL IN AND COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING SIX COURSES WITH A CUMULATIVE 3.0 GPA OR HIGHER.

ET 111B: MATHEMATICS FOR ELECTRONICS APPLICATIONS

ET 131B: DC FOR ELECTRONICS

ET 132B: AC FOR ELECTRONICS

ET 212B: DIGITAL LOGIC I

ET 220B: SOLID-STATE DEVICES AND CIRCUITS I

ET 228B: DATA ACQUISITION

Core classes are taught at the CSN North Las Vegas campus. At the end of each semester, participants should follow up with the JT4 Jump Start Program coordinators regarding their progress through these courses.

Note: Most participants have found that in order to allow for proper school/life/work balance, they require two semesters to complete these courses.



5. CONTACT THE JT4 JUMP START PROGRAM COORDINATORS FOR INFORMATION ON HOW TO APPLY FOR THE POSITION OF ELECTRONIC TECHNICIAN I.

Make sure your transcript indicates all six courses were completed with the necessary cumulative GPA.

6. COMPLETE THE JT4 APPLICATION PROCESS.

Apply online to the appropriate requisition at JT4LLC.com/careers. Note that successful completion of initial course work does not guarantee employment. Expect both a phone and in-person interview.

If you become a member of the JT4 team, you will need to finish the ETDCT-AAS degree program. Employees may be reimbursed for tuition and books for remaining classes completed with a B or better through participation in JT4's generous Employee Educational and Training Assistance Program (EETAP). Jump Start Program participants are encouraged to complete the degree program within two years of being hired to be eligible for promotion to Electronic Technician II or higher.
